



Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The coronavirus has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. According to the CDC, COVID-19, the disease caused by Coronavirus, is highly contagious. The medical community's understanding of COVID-19 is ever evolving. However, the virus is known to spread from person to person through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs. Spread is more likely when people are in close contact with one another (within 6 feet). Individuals may be contagious days before they show any symptoms.

COVID-19 spreads easily and sustainably. There is no known treatment or cure for COVID-19, though vaccines are readily available as well as booster vaccines. Please note that all students, mentors, teachers, Volunteer Camp Staff and OSPREY Camp staff must follow the expectations below in order **to attend Mentor Training Weekend** (for mentors, teachers, Volunteer Camp Staff and OSPREY Camp Staff) **as well as a full week of camp** (for mentors, teachers, students and OSPREY Camp Staff).

- 1) ALL TEACHERS, MENTORS, VOLUNTEER CAMP STAFF AND OSPREY CAMP STAFF MUST BE FULLY VACCINATED. BOOSTERS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR TEACHERS OR MENTORS BUT ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. *IF A SCHOOL/SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUIRES TEACHERS AND STUDENT VOLUNTEERS TO BE BOOSTERED, THEN WE WILL ALSO REQUIRE OUR TEACHERS AND MENTORS TO OBTAIN BOOSTER VACCINES. BOOSTERS ARE REQUIRED FOR OUR VOLUNTEER CAMP STAFF AND OSPREY STAFF. STUDENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE VACCINATED BUT IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

- 2) ALL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS MUST RECEIVE A NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TEST, ONSITE AT SCHOOL, ON THE FIRST DAY OF CAMP BEFORE BOARDING THE BUS. MENTORS, VOLUNTEER CAMP STAFF AND OSPREY CAMP STAFF MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TEST ON THE FIRST DAY OF THEIR ARRIVAL AT CAMP. RESULTS MUST BE SENT TO THE OSPREY CAMP DIRECTOR, VIA PHOTO/TEXT, PRIOR TO COMING TO CAMP. FURTHER DETAILS WILL BE GIVEN CLOSER TO ARRIVAL DATES. ANTIGEN TESTS WILL BE SUPPLIED BY OSPREY CAMP FOR ALL TEACHERS, STUDENTS AND OSPREY CAMP STAFF. MENTORS AND VOLUNTEER CAMP STAFF ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING THEIR OWN ANTIGEN TESTS (WHICH ARE AVAILABLE, FOR FREE, FROM YOUR PHARMACY). ALL TEST RESULTS MUST BE NEGATIVE IN ORDER TO ATTEND CAMP. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

OSPREY Camp and Camp Solomon Schechter are following published guidelines and recommendations from the CDC, the Thurston County Department of Health, the World Health Organization, the U.S. Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OHSA), Camp Solomon Schechter's Medical Advisory Team and the American Camp Association. In addition, we will continue to comply with state and local guidelines regarding COVID-19. Despite these efforts, Camp cannot prevent you from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while traveling to and from camp, as well as being present on our premises. COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

In consideration for your child to enter camp property and attend OSPREY Camp this spring, you and your child agree to follow all published guidelines as well as all policies & procedures issued by OSPREY Camp and Camp Solomon Schechter in relation to COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I have read and understood the above warnings about the risks of contracting COVID-19 and the consequences if I do. With full awareness and appreciation of the risks, I, for myself and on behalf of my family, spouse, estate, heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and personal representatives, forever release and waive my right to sue OSPREY Camp and/or Camp Solomon Schechter, and its owners, directors, trustees, agents, employees, or other representatives in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to my presence on camp property. I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims including claims for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence, and I give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen. I agree the provisions herein are reasonable and enforceable. If any portion or provision of this document is determined to be invalid, or unenforceable, the remainder shall not be affected by such determination and shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
